

Five top tips to secure a traveller injunction

1



Provide good quality dated colour photos, showing the dates they were taken – they can be crucial in securing an injunction.

2



Give full details of the ownership of the land and the identity of its occupiers.

3



Ensure the plan of the area to be covered by the injunction is **clear and unambiguous**.

4



Disclose the planning history of the site. Failure to do so can be disastrous to the application.

5



Move quickly!
